## COVID SAFETY CHECKLIST

ACC SPORT – TERM 1, 2022

Version Date: 31 January 2022

This checklist should be utilised by schools participating in ACC weekly sporting competition in Term 1 to ensure the safety of all participants, staff and officials. The checklist should be used in conjunction with the risk assessment and safety plan.

PRIOR TO COMPETITION DATE		
TICK	DETAILS TO CHECK	COMMENTS
	ACC risk assessment & safety plan checked for each sport – cricket, tennis and volleyball.	
	Host school hiring / utilising an external venue? Contact venue management and confirm details relevant for COVID safety – QR check in requirements, density limits, vaccination requirements etc and obtain a copy of their COVID Safe plan. Communicate relevant details to the visiting / opposition school.	
	Communicate your school's COVID safe requirements to visiting schools and officials, including specific protocols to follow on arrival (QR sign-in), moving through the school grounds to sporting venues, etc.	
	COVID safe signage in place for your school's sporting venues.	
	Ensure that participants and coaching staff have conducted a rapid antigen test (RAT) within 48 hours of the competition commencing and returned a negative result.	
	Limit involvement in the sporting activity to the minimum number of participants required.	

ON COMPETITION DATE		
TICK	DETAILS TO CHECK	COMMENTS
	Any participant, staff member of official displaying COVID symptoms must not attend ACC Sport under any circumstances and should be tested and isolate until they receive a negative result.	
	Mask mandate enforced for all indoor venues and for outdoor spaces where physical distancing cannot be maintained. <b>Exceptions noted below.</b>	
	Hand sanitiser available in multiple locations throughout the sporting venue to ensure good hand hygiene.	
	Avoid handshakes, high fives, etc.	
	Always implement physical distancing practices.	
	Indoor spaces – ensure adequate ventilation within the sporting venue, opening doors and windows as appropriate.	
	Limit spectator involvement where possible (including students, staff members and parents). Where spectators are in attendance, ensure that physical distancing is maintained and that there is no interaction with students or staff.	
	Ensure that there is no sharing of food or drinks.	

***Indoor mask mandate exceptions:***

- All patrons over the age of 8 who are not actively engaged in an exertive role on court – whether as a player, coach or official – are required to wear a mask at all times indoors.
- A medical exemption is applicable where supportive evidence is provided.
